Advanced Trauma Management
& Resuscitation Course

Background:

There were success stories for similar programs around the third world countries from a group in Oxford, endorsed by the “WHO”. They call the modified program “Primary Trauma Care”. The program is based on the principles of the international program “ATLS” which is protected by copy rights and expensive to apply in countries with limited financial resources.

Workshop Outline:

An intensive three-day course on the technique of management of Acute Trauma Resuscitation with HANDS ON Management. The course incorporates lectures on trauma management and small group discussions. The course will provide the opportunity for delegates to practice in simulated situations techniques relevant to trauma resuscitation as well as overall management of trauma victims. It will focus on the theory and practical skills to effectively treat critical trauma patients.

Objectives:

By the end of the Course participants should be able to:

Perform rapid assessment of a multi-trauma patient.

Start resuscitation of trauma patient and appreciate the role of various diagnostic modalities.

Recognize the needs of the patient and appreciate the local capabilities.

Recognize and initiate safe transfer and disposition of the patient.

The Proposal:

Our proposal is to organize a trip for “4” instructors (4 persons in total), to come to Cairo and teach the course as well as train the trainers to run the course locally.

This typically involves 3 cycles; give the course to a group (16-20), then choose trainers from this group (ideally should be the whole group). Train the trainers for 2 days. This is followed by the trainers giving the course to another group (16-20 persons), while they are supported by the original four instructors.

We are able to design and deliver this course for organisations as well as individuals.

Project Outcome:

The trainers are authorities in their specialties Surgery, Orthopaedic, Anaesthesia, Neurosurgery). Enigma will liaise with the Military Academy Egypt and the local universities as well as Ministry of Health. The consultants from the UK can be extremely useful to Egypt. Links could be established in different specialties, other courses in medical education following the same format are currently used in UK. These could be imported modified and applied locally by the local universities in Egypt. To count some are the “Basic Surgical Skills” course and the “Critically Ill Surgical Patient” course endorsed by the royal colleges here.
